**DO NOT put clean up items in regular trash totes. Regular trash totes will be picked up Wednesday, May 8<sup>th</sup> with household waste only.**

**Brush, leaves and other organic material will be picked up with regular trash on scheduled day (Premium Yard Waste Toters, Compost It! bags or stickers MUST be used).**

## Household Hazardous Waste & Tire Drop Off Event

*For Residents Only*

**7am – 3pm**

**Location: Public Works Facility

### Accepted Household Hazardous Waste Items:

Thinners, insecticides, herbicides, drain cleaners, brake fluids, chemical bleaches, oven cleaners, oil based paint, varnishes, paint thinners, oil, anti-freeze, and batteries. Florescent Bulbs

Hazardous waste will **NOT** be picked up at curb!

### TIRES

Residents are allowed up to **five (5)** tires per household.

### Non-Accepted Tire Items:

Tires with rims still attached, solid tires, bike tires, semi, large truck, farm or tractor tires.

### RESIDENTS MAY SET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AT THE CURB:

- Metals
- Furniture
- Garbage (in bags or containers of 50 pounds or less)
- Railroad ties must be cut down to 4ft or shorter lengths
- Dried Latex Paint

**\*\*\*\*\* GAS AND OIL MUST BE DRAINED FROM ALL SMALL ENGINES\*\*\*\*\***

**NO CONCRETE OR CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL WILL BE ACCEPTED**

Construction material includes decking or the demolition of a shed or garage.

NO APPLIANCES OR TV/MONITORS are allowed on the curb for  
Norwalk's Spring Cleaning Days

Electronics & appliances Drop off Site will be open

**Saturday, June 8**  
**7am – 3pm**

**Public Works Facility – 2626 North Avenue**

**This is the only time appliance stickers are NOT required  
And the only date appliances/electronics will be accepted**

**Appliances** include: refrigerators, freezers, kitchen ranges, air conditioning units, dehumidifiers, water heaters, furnaces, thermostats, washers/dryers, dishwashers and microwave ovens

**Electronics** include: Computers, printers, copiers, fax machines, cell phones, VCR's, DVD players and video games systems

**Monitors and TV's will be accepted with a fee (cash only)**

18" and under = \$7.00

19" to 25" = \$12.00

26" to 32" = \$17.00

33" to 40" = \$22.00

41" and up = \$27.00

Console televisions = \$27.00
