



Arrest made in Norwalk School Bomb Threat

February 27, 2014 – On February 6, 2014, the Norwalk Community School District received a bomb threat at the middle school. At that time a note was found in the school bathroom indicating a bomb would explode. Resulting from the threatening note the school was evacuated and several events planned for that evening were canceled.

Since the original call was received, Norwalk Officers have been actively investigating the incident. The investigation culminated in the identification of a suspect and the later arrest of that person on February 26.

The name of the perpetrator is being withheld due to their age. The case has been referred to the Warren County Juvenile Court for processing and further action.
