3. We ask that you have your booth in order and ready to open by 10:00 AM on the 4<sup>th</sup> because people will start lining up for the parade by then.
4. In order to maintain some control and order for the day we ask that your area not be dismantled until 3:00 PM at the earliest, you may stay open later if you so desire.
5. We will have an information booth set up on the grounds and there will also be a staff member present during the day to answer any questions you may have.
6. We hope the weather is great and the public is buying! We wish you good luck, have fun and see you there!
7. If you have an enclosed area and are serving food, we suggest you have a fire extinguisher on hand.
