- Requirements:** High school diploma or GED. 1-2 years of related work experience in clinical/medical and fire experience. Must have Firefighter II, Paramedic or EMT, Hazmat operations, FEMA IS-100a, IS 200a and IS-700. Valid Iowa driver's license and good driving record. Candidate must have the ability to perform all physical functions of the job description.
- Physical/Drug test:** Post offer pre-employment physical and drug test required.
- Pre-Hire:** Only applicants submitting the required application materials and meeting the minimum requirements for the job will be invited for the written examination. Applicants must score a minimum of 75% on the test. Those that pass the test will be required to pass a physical agility test. Applicants that pass the written test and the physical ability test will be invited to an oral board examination. The date, time and location of these exams will be provided to applicants who meet the requirements.
- Notes:** The written exam is composed of examination questions designed to measure the applicants skill and knowledge of Firefighter I and II concepts, EMT or Paramedic knowledge.

Post offer pre-employment physical, drug screen, driver's record and DCI background check will be required.
