



Youth Day Off Activities

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED

This year we will offer afternoon early out field trips to various attractions in and around the metro area when kids are off from school. The trips are held on specific non-school days. These trips are for kids in 3rd, 4th and 5th grade. Students will meet and board the bus at Lakewood Elementary School at 1pm. **Important: Snacks are NOT included in this year's activities, send extra money if your child wants a snack.** Register for all events at once, or monthly. We have arranged for the following:

- 1) **November 7 - Sky Zone:** Get ready for a seemingly endless sea of trampolines, all connected to form one massive trampoline surface. The surface is enclosed with angled trampolines that allow you to literally bounce off the walls! These patented, all-trampoline, walled playing courts are the foundation of Sky Zone Indoor Trampoline Park. It's a playing court so original and unique, creating a brand new way to move, compete and get fit!
- 2) **December 30 - Sleepy Hollow Sports Park:** You know how fun sledding is - tubing is even better! The hill at Sleepy Hollow is 15 stories high and you don't have to walk back up! As the surface lifts pull you to the top, prepare for the release, which sends you flying down the 1,000-foot runs. All lanes are constantly monitored for everyone's safety. Tubes will be provided. Dress warm (gloves, hats and boots).
- 3) **January 3 - Movie Day @ Jordan Creek:** Kick back and enjoy a movie at Jordan Creek Century 21 Theatre. We give the kids a choice between two movies and it will be rated G or PG.
- 4) **February 20 - Climb Iowa:** Climb Iowa is Iowa's largest indoor climbing and training facility, with more than 10,000 square feet of climbing, 200 routes and problems. Included in the price is all climbing equipment and 2 hours of unlimited climbing. A safety waiver must be completed and turned in to participate in this program
- 5) **March 19 - Incredible Pizza of Urbandale:** Over 100 games, ticket games, and simulators await you! Included in the price will be an arcade game card and 2 hours of unlimited attractions such as bumper cars, go-karts, mini bowling, or mini golf! Must be 50" for bumper cars.
