
Wakonda Drive Neighborhood Project

Spring has sprung and construction has begun.

Wednesday, March 9, 2016 - The curb and gutter will be torn out and replaced on the south side of Wakonda Drive at the intersection of Waveland Drive and moving west to the first driveway. This replacement should fix the ponding of water that has occurred at this location.

Starting Wednesday afternoon, crews will begin finishing the sidewalks along Wakonda Drive.

Friday, March 11, 2016 - A portion of the west bound lane at 4657 Wakonda Drive will be removed to repair the large dip that has developed. The street will remain open however, it will be limited to one lane in this area.

MAILBOXES: Under the direction of the Norwalk Post Master, we have been advised that cluster mailboxes will be permanently installed along Wakonda Drive. We are working to finalize a map for the location of these boxes before the Post Master places the order for the new cluster boxes.

STREET LIGHTS: We are working with MidAmerican Energy on returning all of the street lights to Wakonda Drive. There are several lights that needed to be relocated due to conflicts. The plan is to have these installed as close to their original location as possible.
