## NORWALK OUTBOARD SHUFFLEBOARD RULES

(10-Frame)

### PLAY:

To Start, the four RED disks are placed within the left half of the 10-OFF area and the BLACK discs with the right side.

Players slide discs using a cue (stick) starting with red.

If a disc does not reach the furthest dead line, remove from play immediately.

Discs that tip off the edge of the court should also be removed immediately.

Alternate players for each shot.

Goal is to both eliminate your opponent from the board and scoring the most points possible for your team.

Note: "middle line" in 10-OFF area does not begate the -10 score, unlike other lines.

### SCORING:

Once all eight discs are played, score for each team, PLUS in the 'triangle' and MINUS for the 10-OFF area.

Example: +8 and a -10 would result in a -2 score for that frame/person.

A disc must be entirely within one of the five areas and not touching the outside lines of that area in order to score the amount marked within.

Discs beyond 10-OFF area are ignored.

Discs on top of other disks are also scored.

Judges should position the eye directly above discs in order to decide whether or not a line is being touched.

NET totals are scored after each frame and highest total wins after ten frames.
