• Norwalk Parks and Recreation Greenways Committee

The Greenways Committee will have ten members, and its volunteer citizen members will ideally represent a wide variety of greenways users, including a range of ages and abilities, different levels of recreational users, school and work commuters, health and wellness professionals, and the business community.

The Greenways Committee's work will begin in May 2019 and end with the Greenways Plan's presentation to City Council in the fall of 2020. Committee members can expect to attend one, regular monthly meeting; assist City staff and consultants with research, including an inventory of existing greenways; and participate in ad hoc events such as public hearings and public input-gathering sessions. The average time commitment for a Committee member is estimated to be one to three hours a month.
