

ORDINANCE NO. 19-07

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR INCREASED EMS FEES, AND AMENDING SECTION 177.01(3), NORWALK MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWALK, IOWA:

Be it ordained by the City Council, City of Norwalk Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Section 177.01(3), Norwalk Municipal Code, by providing for annual increases in EMS fees for the City of Norwalk, Iowa. These increases represent an 8% increase in fees per year for five successive years with the first increase to take effect on July 1, 2018 and on the first day of July of each year thereafter for five years.

Section 2. Fees. Section 177.01(3), Norwalk Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows for fees effective July 1, 2018:

Basic Life Support (emergency)	\$628.56 per occurrence
Advanced Life Support 1 (emergency)	\$746.28 per occurrence
Advanced Life Support 2	\$1081.08 per occurrence
Paramedic Tier Charge	\$162.00 per occurrence
Mileage	\$12.96 per loaded mile
Treat and release	\$162.00 per occurrence

Section 3. Future Fee Adjustments. The above fees shall be adjusted annually increasing at a rate of 8% above the previous year's rates for a total of five years including the rate set herein effective July 1, 2018. Subsequent rate adjustments, pursuant to this Ordinance, shall occur on July 1 of the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022.

Section 4. Repealer. This ordinance will repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the

validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. When Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon approval and publication.
