



Greg Staples Accepts Appointment as New Police Chief

"We are very excited that Mr. Staples has agreed to become Norwalk's next Chief of Police. His education, experience and enthusiasm made him the top candidate for the position," said Mayors Pierce and Phillips. "He currently serves the community of Roanoke, Virginia as Captain of the Services Division and his work there has prepared him well to take on the new challenge."

Mr. Staples thanked the Mayors and Council for giving him the opportunity to serve and said, "I am honored to be selected for appointment as Norwalk's new police chief. I look forward to meeting the entire community and I am eager to get started."

Mr. Staples holds a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice, has 24 years of law enforcement service, and has embraced community policing throughout his career with a track record of successful programs. He plans to begin employment with the City on February 3, 2014.
